

2012 Grandview Finale Feature Only Handicapping/Full Point Race

- ❖ Top 20 in driver and owner points after the conclusion of the final event prior to the Season Finale

Feature only line-up will invert top 12 in owner points, 13-20 in owner points start straight up.

In the event an owner in the top 20 declines the invitation to compete, 13th in owner points will NOT advance to the pole. Only the top 12 owners in points as of next to last race can be inverted.

If an owner in the top 20 in points elects to seat a driver who is outside the top 20 in points, said driver will start last.

Any driver who is in the top 12 in points that elects to drive a car that is outside the top 20 in points, said driver would start behind inverted top 12 owners. Any driver from 13-20 in points that elects to drive a car outside the top 20 in points, will retain their starting position.

Once the top twenty starting positions have been filled (we will continue down the point list after 20th spot, until all spots have been filled) provisional spots will become available. Provisionals are available regardless of whether a URC car has taken a provisional during the regular URC season or not. However, it is important to note, that no car owner or driver outside the top twenty in points, will be awarded any points. The top 20 car owners and drivers are locked into a point fund check after the completion of the Oct. 1, Delaware race. No car owner or driver outside the top 20 can advance in points at the URC finale.

Our purse is structured to accommodate 20 cars...after that, any car interested in being added to the show must do so as a provisional, and pay for last position.

All cars must be URC legal.

Adjustments to this procedure are at the discretion of the URC management and include starting position penalties for any driver or owner who competes directly against URC or may lose their status as a member in good standing. This includes being moved outside the top 12 starting positions, moved to the rear of the field and includes being un-invited to the event.

URC will notify the driver and owner of their penalty starting position a minimum of one week prior to the race.
